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## Preface

### Overview

This publication reflects data collected in the hospital licensure process. Historical accounting of the responsibility for this function began in 1946 when the Mississippi Commission on Hospital Care was legislatively authorized to license federal hospitals and prepare an annual report. In 1979 the legislature passed a bill to merge the responsibilities of the Commission on Hospital Care into the Mississippi Hospital Care Commission and in 1986 another bill was passed to merge the responsibilities of the Commission on Hospital Care into the Mississippi State Department of Health.

In October 1998, the Division of Health Facilities Licensure and Certification mailed copies of its combined "Annual Hospital Report and Application for Renewal of Hospital Licensure" and the American Hospital Association's "Annual Survey of Hospitals" to all non-federal hospitals in Mississippi. This survey is the source of statistics for this publication. A copy of the survey form is included in Appendix E. The hospital survey forms were reviewed and automated by the Division of Public Health Statistics. Questions regarding reported data were answered by hospital personnel through telephone calls.

In 1982, for planning purposes, the Statewide Health Coordinating Council established seven hospital service areas based on where patients sought hospital care. For ease in using the data presented in this report some tables are presented by planning service areas. Map II displays the hospital service areas.

This Annual Report is based on 107 hospitals; 101 acute care, 4 psychiatric rehabilitation, and 2 long-term acute care. Data for Restorative Care Hospital is included in acute care. The five federal hospitals in Mississippi have been excluded. Additionally, East Mississippi State Hospital, Mississippi State Hospital, Oak Grove Center and Whitfield Medical/Surgical Hospital have been excluded from all data. Map I, Table II and Table III. Map I shows location of hospitals by type of facility. Table II shows accreditations and Table III displays employees.

### Hospital Ownership and Certification

As Map I indicates, the overwhelming majority, 101, of hospitals in Mississippi are classified as medical/surgical. There are eight psychiatric/mental hospitals, one rehabilitation hospital, and two long-term acute hospitals. These figures were determined by the type of service that the hospitals provided to the majority of admissions.

The seven counties in Mississippi that do not have a hospital are Amite, Carroll, Greene, Issaquena, Itawamba and Tunica. The counties having the most hospitals are Hinds and Rankin with seven, Harrison and Lauderdale with six. Sixteen counties have 2 hospitals and fifty-four counties have one hospital.

Ownership and control of hospitals and beds are shown in Tables I-A through I-F. In 1997 there were 101 acute care hospitals and 11,841 licensed acute care beds. This count excludes Whitfield Medical Surgical Hospital and includes Restorative Care Hospital at Baptist, Specialty Hospital of Biloxi and Specialty Hospital of Meridian.) The hospitals reported 670 licensed psychiatric beds. Approximately 57% of the beds were located at acute care hospitals. Seventeen hospitals reported 427 license dependency beds. Trace Regional Hospital did not report any chemical dependency utilization during the reporting period. Approximately 88% (377 beds) were located

acute care facilities. Seven hospitals reported 278 rehabilitation beds. More (154) were located at 6 acute care facilities.

Table II indicates that 54.5% of the hospitals are accredited by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organization (JCAHO). Almost all of hospitals, 95.5% participate in Blue Cross and 93.8 participate in Medicare, and participate in Medicaid.

### Hospital Employees

Table III displays hospital personnel. Mississippi's hospitals employed 5 people during FY 98; 81.6% of which were full-time employees and 18.4% of which time employees.

Hospital service areas are shown in Map II.

Seventy-seven hospitals reported 115,740 inpatient surgeries and eighty hospitals reported 130,041 outpatient surgeries. This count includes on surgeries performed at acute care hospitals. As Table X shows, the majority of were performed in Service Area 3.

Table XI presents outpatient emergency visits and clinic/other visits by Service Area. Service Area 3 reported both the most outpatient emergency visits and clinic/other visits.

Thirty hospitals reported 61 rural health clinics and 417,261 rural health visits. Table XII shows rural health clinics and visits by hospital service area.

### Bed Changes

Biloxi Specialty Hospital opened April 1, 1998 with 42 acute care beds.

Baptist Memorial Hospital North Miss. increased acute care beds from 153

to 199.

Franklin County Hospital decreased from 40 acute care beds to 36.

Hancock Medical Center increased acute care beds from 66 to 104.

Memorial Hospital at Gulfport increased acute care beds from 274 to 283 and increased rehabilitation beds from 20 to 33.

Miss. Baptist Medical Center decreased acute care beds from 541 to 519 and increased adult chemical dependency beds from 60 to 100.

Miss. State Hospital decreased psychiatric beds from 1417 to 1374 and increased adult chemical dependency beds from 89 to 132.

Newton Regional hospital increased from 39 acute care beds to 49.

North Miss. Medical Center increased adult chemical dependency beds from 1 and decreased adolescent chemical dependency beds from 13 to 15.

Rankin Medical Center increased from 90 to 134 acute care beds.

Singing River Hospital increased adult psychiatric beds from 18 to 30.

The 8 adult chemical dependency beds at Smith County Hospital were decertified.

Specialty Hospital of Meridian increased from 20 to 40 beds.

University Medical Center increased acute care beds from 531 to 577.

Yalobusha General Hospital decreased from 32 to 26 beds.

## Licensed Beds, Average Length of Stay, Average Daily Census and Occupancy Rate

Table XIII shows hospitals and beds by bed size groupings. Occupancy rate also shown by bed size. Under acute care the greatest number of hospital beds reported at hospitals with 25 - 49 beds, 50-99 beds, and 100-199 beds. Of the hospitals reporting psychiatric beds, 5 were licensed as psychiatric hospitals. hundred fifteen chemical dependency beds were reported at 16 hospitals. This does not include the 12 cdu beds at Trace Regional Hospital. Seven hospitals report rehabilitation beds. Map III looks at the distribution of 107 Mississippi hospital beds by bed size and county.

Table XIV-A gives average lengths of stay (ALOS), average daily census (ADC) and percentages of occupancy for each hospital by licensed acute care bed capacity totals. Psychiatric data can be found in Table XIV-B, chemical dependency data in Table XIV-C, and rehabilitation data in Table XIV-D. Map IV displays location of psychiatric, chemical dependency and rehabilitation beds.

A comparison of licensed beds and beds set up and staffed is shown in Table XV-D. Of the 11,841 licensed acute beds, 10,686 beds were set up and staffed. hundred sixty of the 670 licensed psychiatric beds were set up and staffed. Fourteen of the 427 licensed chemical dependency beds were set up and staffed. hundred thirty-eight of the 278 rehabilitation beds were set up and staffed.

### Swing Beds

Table XVI shows the number of swing beds, average length of stay and average census by facility. Table XVII shows the destination of discharged swing beds: number referred to home health, and number of acute care beds designated as swing service area. More than one-half (55.3%) were discharged to their home, 14.2% discharged to nursing homes, 10.6% were admitted to hospitals, 1.5% were admitted to personal care homes, and remaining 18.5% were discharged to other destinations.

Swing bed utilization in 1998 by hospital service area is shown in Table XVIII.

### Hospital Use Statistics

Table XIX shows the population of each service area in comparison with its bed capacity. Service areas are maintaining a relatively close correlation between percentage of population and percentage of licensed hospital beds. Service Area including the city of Jackson and Hinds County, has the largest population at 20.8% and the most beds at 30.8%. Licensed beds by type are also shown by hospital service area.

Table XX-A provides information on acute hospital beds, admissions, discharges, deaths and inpatient days by service area and county. Psychiatric, chemical dependency and rehabilitation beds located in acute care facilities are included in Table XX-B with those facilities that are licensed as psychiatric, or rehabilitation facilities. There are 11,841 licensed acute care hospital beds in Mississippi, 670 psychiatric, 427 chemical dependency beds, and 278 rehabilitation beds.

A comparison of utilization statistics for 1988, 1993 and 1998 is shown in Table XXI. While acute care data decreased from 1988 to 1998, psychiatric, chemical



and rehabilitation data increased.

Table XXII deals with newborn statistics. Once again, Service Area 3 leads every category, as does Hinds County. Table XXIII compares with the newborn statistics 1998 with those of 1993 and 1988. There was a -7.1% percent of change in bassinets, -5.6 percent of change in obstetrical beds set up and staffed. Deliveries increased slightly from 1988-1998. The percent of change in fetal deaths was -26.6%.

Table XXIV displays discharges, discharge days, admissions and inpatient days for the service area for DP SNF, geriatric psychiatric DP, patients 65 and older, Medicare and Medicaid.

Table XXV-A shows beds set up, discharges, discharge days and inpatient days for the State's 101 acute care hospitals. Psychiatric, chemical dependency and rehabilitation data reported by these hospitals is included. Data reported by specialty hospitals is reported in Table XXV-B. Data is broken down into acute care, intensive care, and long-term care. No data was reported for psychiatric intensive care, hospital psychiatric long term care or mental retardation.

### Obstetrical Utilization

1998 obstetrical utilization is shown in Appendix A.

### 1998 Hospital Patient Origin Data

Percent of hospital discharges by adjacent county of residence by rank order combined four quarter patient origin study is shown in Appendix B. Discharges from all counties are grouped together under all others. Patient Origin Study dates use combined data include October 6 - 19, 1997, January 5 - 18, 1998, April 6 - 19, 1998, July 6 - 19, 1998. These dates correspond with the majority of hospitals' fiscal years from October 1, 1997 through September 30, 1998.

### Hospital Listing

Hospitals are listed alphabetically by county in Appendix C. The hospital directory is located in Appendix D. The licensed bed capacity is reported as of October 1, 1998 whereas the rest of the report is as of the end of the reporting period September 30, 1998.
