Home Health Agencies

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## Overview

Sixty-three home health agencies responded to the 2001 survey; 27 free-standing, 22 hospital-based, and 14 health department home health agencies. Three home health agencies had a change of ownership and did not submit a report; Alliance Laird Hospital, Gulf Coast Home Care and Miss. Home Care.

Gentiva Health services change to Southern Home Care. The three agencies not participating also changed names. Laird Hospital changed to Alliance Hospital, Crosby Memorial Hospital Home Health changed to Gulf Coast Home Care and Haworth Home Health Agency changed to Miss. Home Care.

Map I shows the location of home health agencies by type in 2001.

Table I shows that 52% of home health agencies reported non-profit status. Approximately 57% of the agencies were controlled by corporations, 22% were controlled by state government, 19% were controlled by local government and the remaining 1.6% were controlled by sole proprietorship.

Referrals by type of home health agency are shown in Table II. Of the 59,703 total referrals, 53,522 or 89.6% were accepted. Reasons for denied service are shown in Table II. Besides the category 'other', not meeting home health service eligibility was the main reason patients were denied service. Most referrals, 92.9% were from physicians and hospitals.

For this report, data from hospital-based home health agencies are shown in tables ending in an A, health department home health agencies are shown in tables ending in a B, free-standing home health agencies are shown in tables ending in a C, and tables ending in a D represent state totals.

## Patients Served

There were 55,650 patients served during 2001. This is a non-duplicate count of people. Total number of patients served during 2000 was 58,692.

Table III shows type of services provided by home health agencies. Skilled nursing, home health aides and physical therapy are provided by all home health agencies. Sixty-two agencies provided speech/audio services and occupational therapy services, 60 agencies provided social services, 21 agencies provided nutrition and 3 agencies provided respiratory therapy. Appliance/equipment data is no longer being captured.

Map II displays number of agencies serving each county. Counties in central, coastal and southeastern areas are served by more home health



agencies. Included in the count are total number of agencies authorized to serve counties.

Table IV shows home health patients served by source of payment. The majority of patients, 51,745 or 75.3% were covered by Medicare, followed by 10,350 or 15% by Medicaid. The remaining 6,595 patients were covered by private insurance, self pay, or charity.

Chart I displays percent of home health agency patients served by type of agency.

Table V displays number of patients served by agency during calendar year 2001 by source of payment. Of hospital-based home health agencies, North Mississippi Medical Center served the most patients, 5,877, followed by Baptist Home Health Center with 4,491 patients served. Southwest Home Health Agency Region C and Southeast Home Health Agency Region A served the most health department patients, 346 and 270 respectively. Of free-standing agencies, South Miss Home Health Region I served the most patients, 3,948.

Chart II displays number and percent of patients served, and Table VI provides number of patients served by agency by county. Table VII shows number of patients served by type of service. Skilled nursing services had the greatest number of patients, 55,755 followed by home health aides, 27,312.

Patients served during calendar year 2001 by type of services provided by county may be found in Table VIII.

Chart III displays total home health agency patients served during calendar year 2001 by type of services provided.

Map III shows home health regions within public health districts. At the present time there are no agencies in District III.

Table IX shows home health patients served by Region. Region V served the most patients, 13,562 or 19.7%, followed by Region IX with 9,426 or 13.7%.

Home health patients served during calendar years 1986-2001 by type of service are shown in Table X. Patients served increased from 40,131 in 1986 to 60,767 in 1991 to 68,690 in 2001. Home health patients served during calendar years 1985 - 2000 may be found in Appendix Table I.

## Visits

Table XI displays home health agency visits by source of payment. The majority of visits, 1,506,752 or 65.8%, were paid by Medicare, followed by Medicaid which paid for 667,994 or 29.2%. Private insurance, self pay and charity made up the other 5.1%.

Chart IV shows percent of home health visits by method of payment. For example, of the total Medicare 1,506,752 visits, 61.8% or 930,631 were free-standing agency visits. Approximately 34.5% or 521,396 were hospital-based visits. Health department visits accounted for the remaining 54,725 visits.

Home health agency visits by agency during calendar year 2001 by source of payment may be found in Table XII. Of the hospital-based agencies, North Mississippi Medical Center reported the most visits, 260,800, followed by Baptist Home Health Services with 113,037. Southwest Home Health Agency Region C reported the most health department visits with 15,519. South Mississippi Home Health Region I reported the most free-standing visits with 143,732 followed by Sta-Home Health Agency Carthage with 138,268 visits.

Home Health Agency visits by agency may be found in Table XIII.

Table XIV shows number of patient visits by type of service. County data is shown in Table XV. Home health aide visits accounted for over one-half of the 2,290,859 visits. Skilled nursing comprised 33% and physical therapy 11.7%. Social services, speech/audiology, occupational therapy and nutrition services made up the other 66,924 visits. No respiratory therapy visits were reported.

Chart V shows percent of home health visits by type of service.

Table XVI shows home health visits by home health regions. Region V reported the most visits with 382,588, followed by Region II with 333,193, and Region III with 312,101.

Total home health agency visits during calendar years 1986-2001 are shown in Table XVII. Home health agency visits increased from 1,286,359 in 1986 to 3,944,520 in 1991 to 2,290,859 visits in 2001.

Home health agency admissions by agency by county are reported in Table XVIII.

Total home health agency patient census increased by 1,311 patients. Table XIX shows that the beginning census was 15,252 and ending census was 16,563.

Employee data are shown in Table XX. Nurses and aides constitute the largest group of employees, 2,275 or 60% of the total. Home health employees decreased from 4,132 in 2000 to 3,793 in 2001.

An alphabetical listing of home health agencies can be found in Appendix A.

There is a list of home health agencies by classification by county in Appendix B. Counties served by each agency are indicated. A copy of the survey instrument and instructions may be found in Appendix C.

## Defi ni ti ons

Branch Office shall mean a location or site from which a home health agency provides services within a portion of the total geographic area served by the parent agency. The branch office is part of the home health agency and is located sufficiently close (within a fifty (50) mile radius) to share administration, supervision and services in a manner that renders it unnecessary to obtain a separate license as a home health agency. A branch office shall be staffed with at least one (1) registered nurse on a full-time basis.

Directly shall mean providing home health services through salaried employees of the home health agency or through personnel under hourly or per visit contracts or the equivalent. Where an hourly or per visit contract is made, Part V Section H must be followed to ensure adequate control and supervision by the home health agency.

Geographic Area shall mean the land area, for which the agency shall be licensed, consisting of not more than a fifty (50) mile radius surrounding the home health agency's office location. The geographic area shall be expressed in Mississippi counties.

Home Health Agency shall mean a public or privately owned agency or organization, or a subdivision of such an agency or organization, properly authorized to conduct business in Mississippi, which is primarily engaged in providing to individuals at the written direction of a licensed physician, in the individual's place of residence, skilled nursing services provided by or under the supervision of a Registered Nurse licensed to practice in Mississippi, and one or more of the following part-time or intermittent services or items:

- a. physical, occupational or speech therapy
- b. medical social services
- c. home health aide services
- d. other services as approved by the licensing agency
- e. medical supplies, other than drugs and biologicals, and the use of medical appliances
- f. medical services provided by a resident in training at a hospital under a teaching program of such hospital.

Parent Home Health Agency shall mean the agency that develops and maintains administrative control of sub-units and/or branches.

Patient's Residence shall mean the place where the patient makes his home, such as his own apartment or house, a relative's home but shall not include a hospital, nursing home or other extended care facility with the exception of services provided through outpatient therapy in a nursing home.

Skilled Nursing Services shall mean patient care services pertaining to the curative, restorative, and preventive aspects of nursing

performed by or under the supervision of a registered nurse pursuant to the plan of treatment established in consultation with appropriate members of the care team. Skilled nursing service is nursing care emphasizing a high level of nursing direction, observation and skill. Sub-Unit shall mean a semi-autonomous organization which serves patients in a geographic area different from that of the parent agency. A sub-unit shall be licensed separately from the parent agency and shall not have a branch office.

## Location of Home Health Agencies As of December 31, 2001

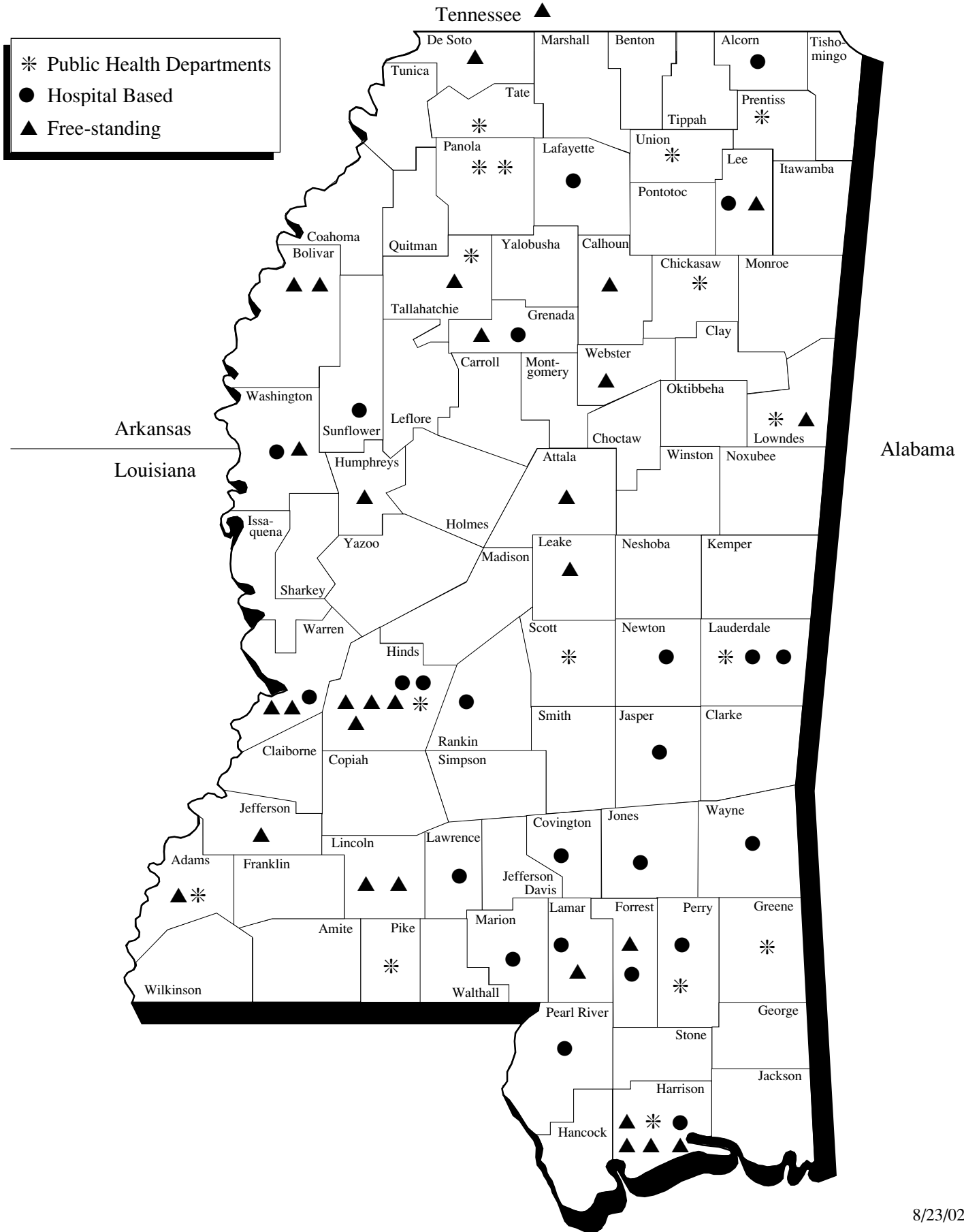

# Map II Number of Home Health Agencies Serving Counties

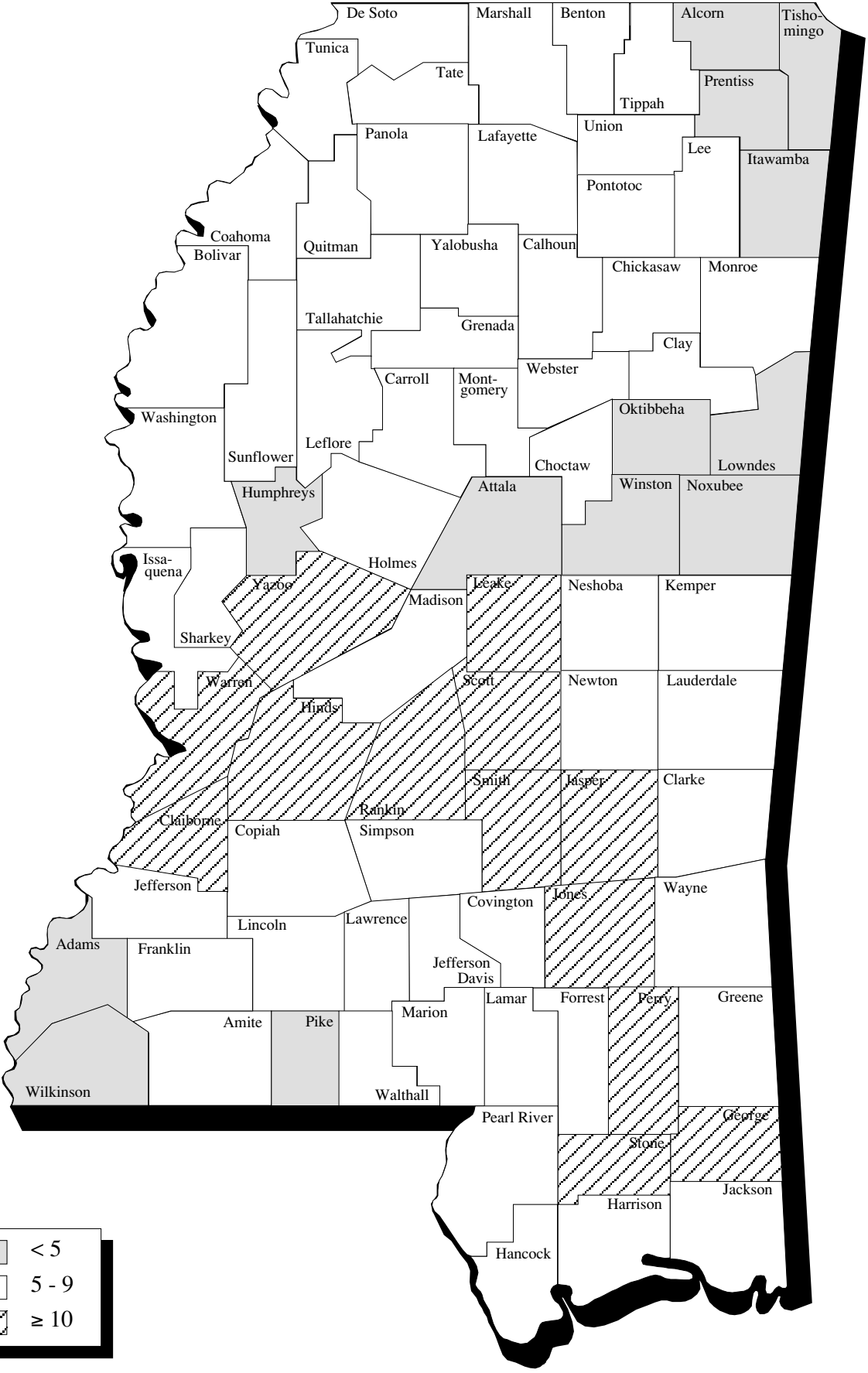

**by Type of Agency**

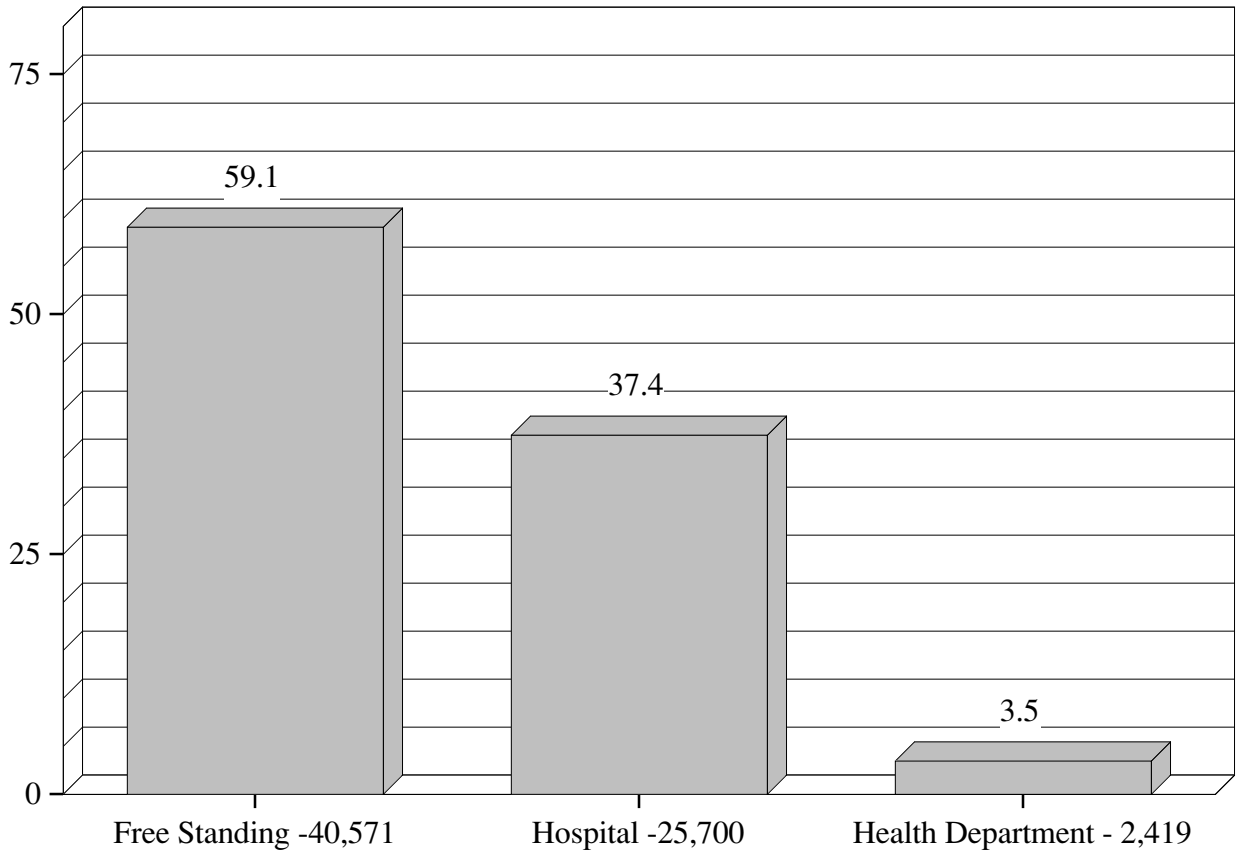

**by Method of Payment**

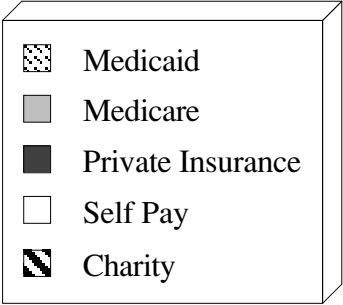
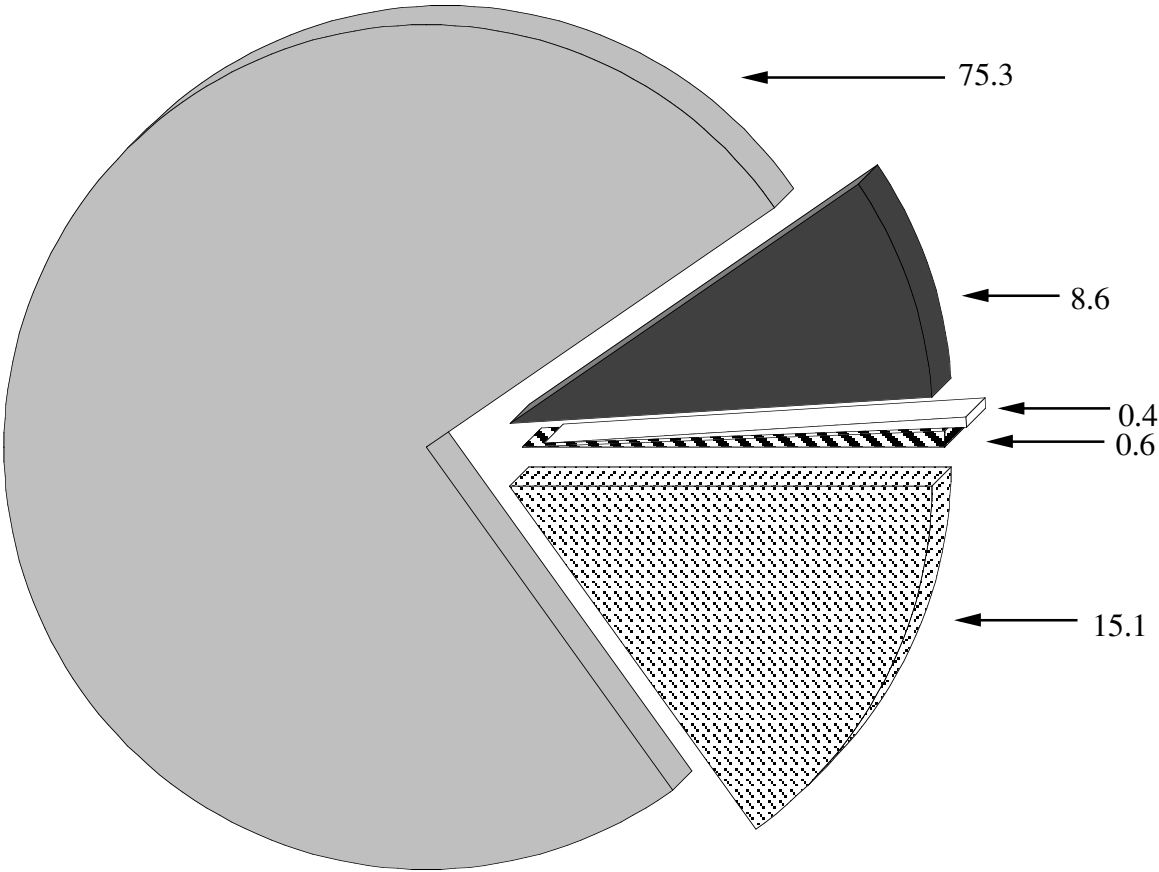

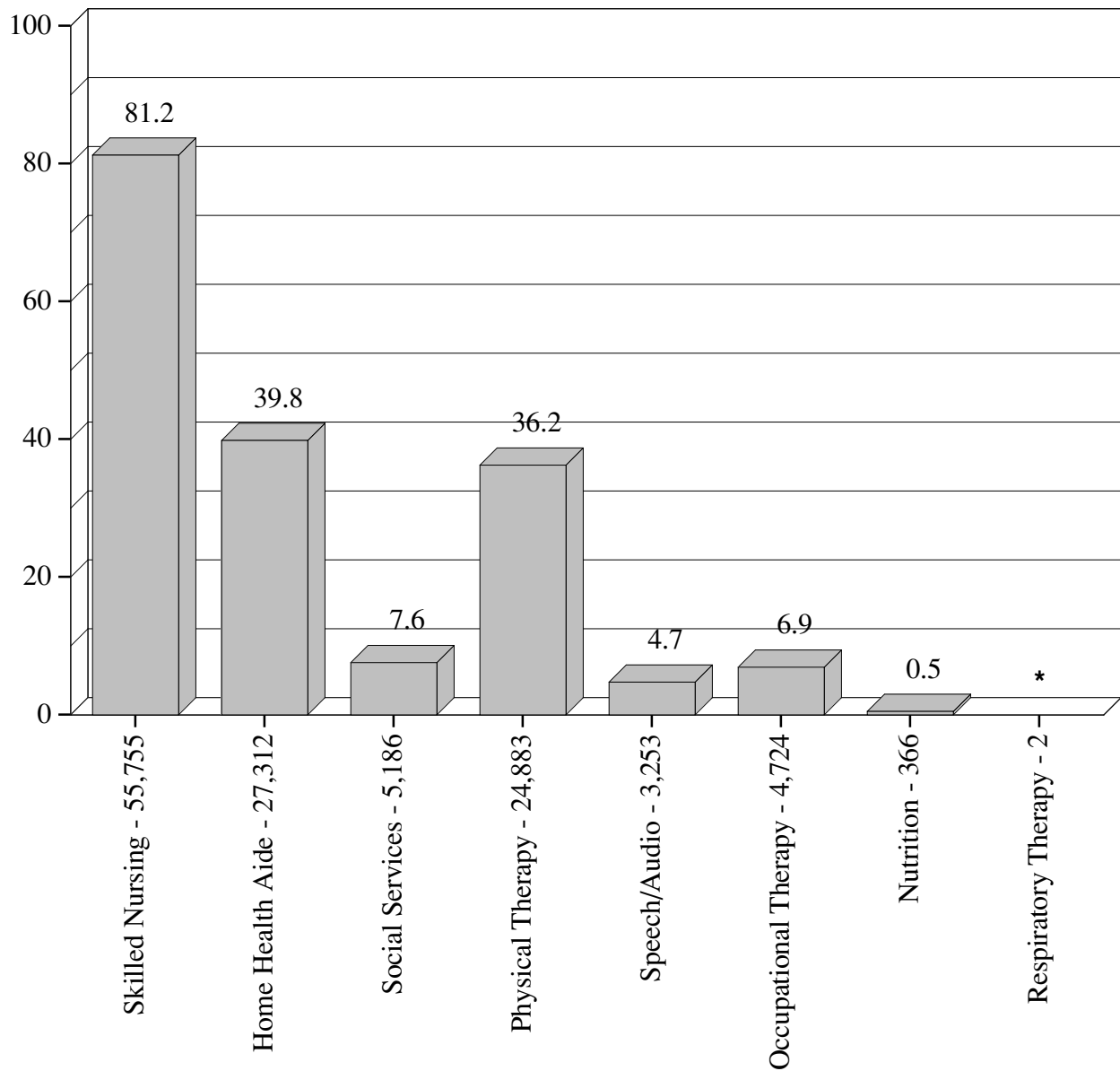

# Map III Public Health Districts and Home Health Regions

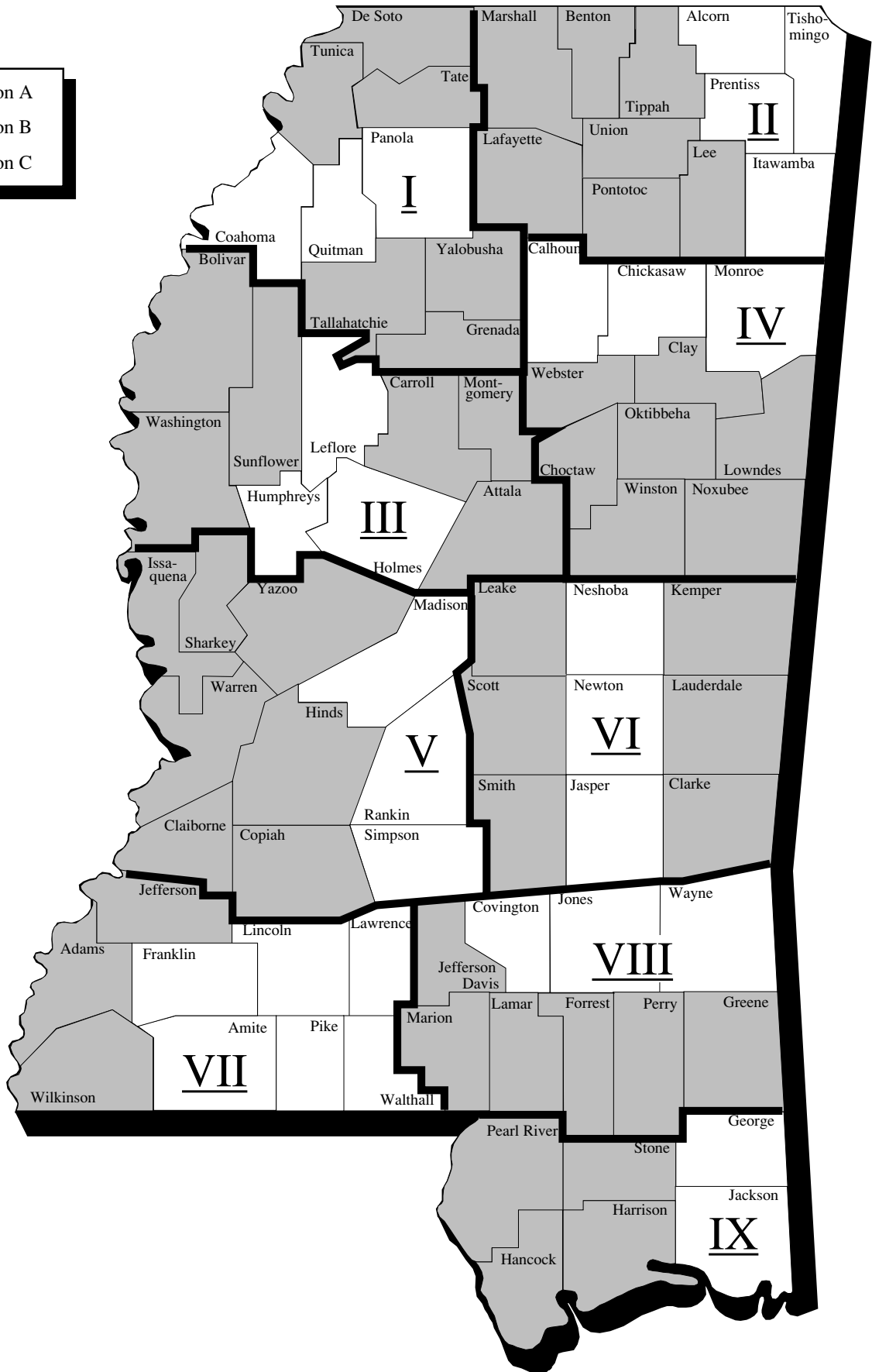
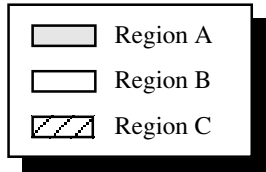

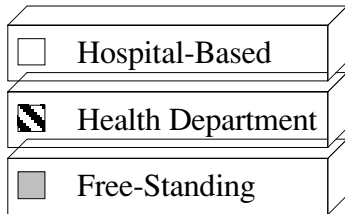
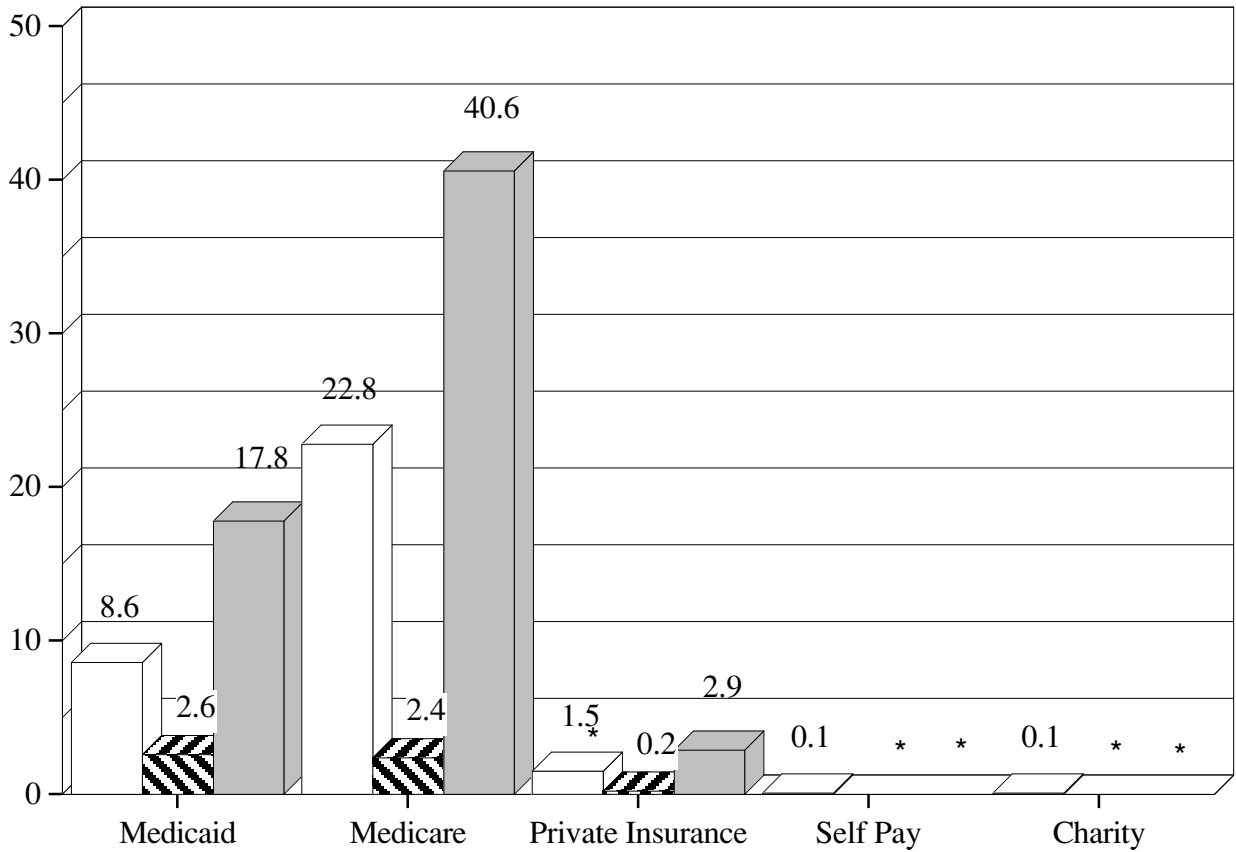

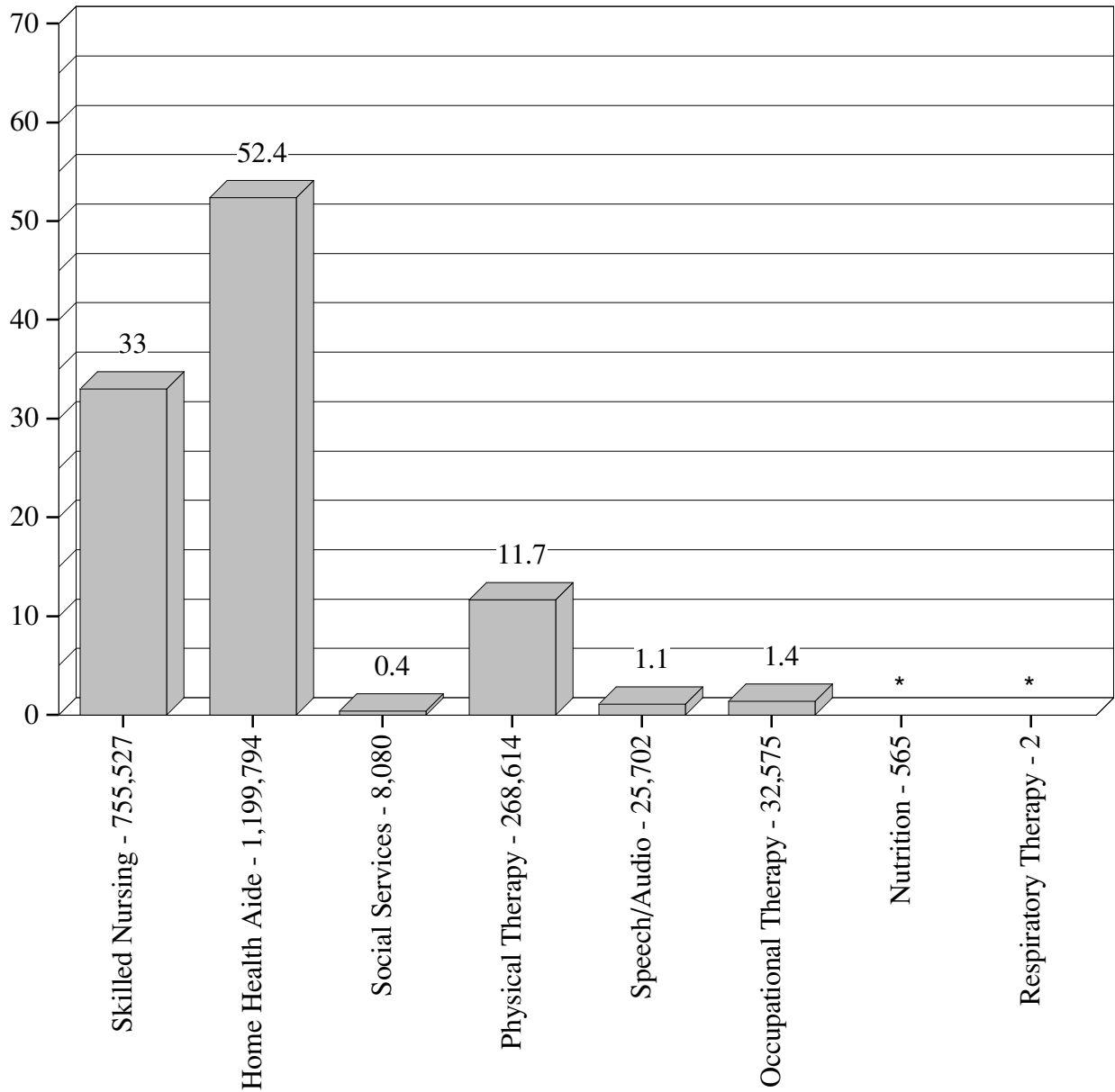
